## Solution 2: Youth Entrepreneurship Programs

This initiative aims to foster innovation, encourage self-employment, and stimulate economic growth by nurturing the next generation of entrepreneurs.

### Solution Elements

### Solution Elements

## Solution 5: Youth Advisory Council

### Solution Elements
